PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ of Habeas Corpus, by calling for the records relating to the impugned order of detention made in P.D.O.No.48/2022 dated 30.11.2022



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on the file of the District Collector and District Magistrate, Pudukkottai District, the second respondent herein, branding the petitioner's son/detenu by name Arjunan, S/o.Palani, aged 28 years as 'Goonda' who is now confined in Central Prison, Tiruchirappalli, Tiruchirappalli District and quash the impugned order of detention and set him at liberty by producing him before this Court.

ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by M.S.RAMESH,J.)

The petitioner is the mother of the detenu viz., Arjunan, S/o.Palani, aged about 28 years. The detenu has been detained by the second respondent by his order in P.D.O.No.48/2022 dated 30.11.2022 holding him to be a "Goonda", as contemplated under Section 2(f) of Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982. The said order is under challenge in this Habeas Corpus Petition.

2. We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents. We have also perused the records produced by the Detaining Authority.



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3. Among other grounds, the detention order is mainly attacked on the ground that there is a delay in passing the order of detention. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner strongly contended that though the detenu was arrested on 29.09.2022, the detention order was passed only on 30.11.2022, i.e., after a considerable delay of 62 days. Therefore, the detention order has to be set aside.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor strongly opposed the Habeas Corpus Petition by filing his counter. It is further submitted that investigation has been completed in this case and final report has been filed in S.C.No.14 of 2023 and the same is pending before the Principal District Court, Pudukottai.

5. As seen from the grounds of detention, it is clear that though the detenu was arrested on 29.09.2022, the order of detention came to be passed only on 30.11.2022 and hence, there is an abnormal delay in passing the order of detention, which caused prejudice to the interest of the detenu.



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6. We have gone through the entire materials placed on record. There is no satisfactory explanation offered by the Detaining Authority for the delay in passing the order of detention. Hence the impugned order of detention is liable to be set aside.

7. In the result, the Habeas Corpus Petition is allowed and the order of detention in P.D.O.No.48/2022 dated 30.11.2022 passed by the second respondent is set aside. The detenu, viz., Arjunan, S/o.Palani, aged about 28 years, is directed to be released forthwith unless his detention is required in connection with any other case.
