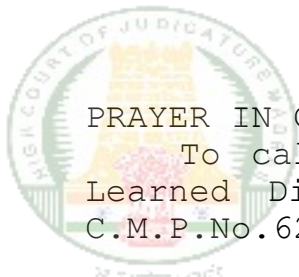

The Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking orders to condone the delay of 968 days in representing the Criminal Revision petition in Crl.R.C.(MD)SR. No.16659 of 2018.

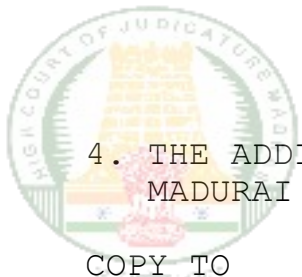
