2.When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) would submit that in this case, after completion of investigation, the respondent police had filed the charge sheet and the same was taken on file as S.C.No.432 of 2022, on the file of the I Additional District Court, Tirunelveli.



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3.The main contention of the petitioner is that though the averments in the complaint attract the provisions of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes Act, the same were not included.

4.Recording the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), this criminal original petition is disposed of. The petitioner is at liberty to file a protest petition before the concerned Court.
