Prayer in CRL RC(MD). 949/ 2022 :

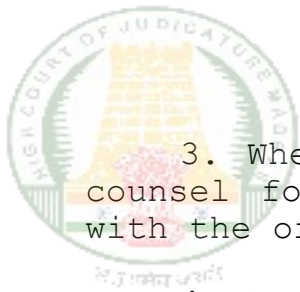

Order : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.RAJARAM.A, Advocate for the petitioner and of MR.B.MAHENDRARAJAN, Advocate on behalf of the Respondents 1 & 2, the court made the following order:-

This petition has been filed to extend the time to pay the entire arrear amount of Rs.80,000/- made in Crl.M.P.(MD)No.11707 of 2022 in Crl.R.C(MD)No.949 of 2022, dated 28.09.2022.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing on 28.09.2022, this Court directed the petitioner to pay the entire arrear amount as directed by the trial Court to the respondent on or before 17.10.2022 and that subsequently, time was extended thrice and
