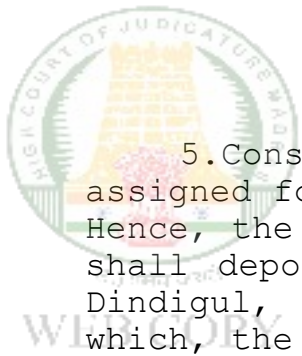
This Petition has been filed to condone the delay of 103 days in filing the above revision challenging the order passed by the Family Court, Dindigul District, in M.C.No.21 of 2020, dated 01.07.2022.

2. Records perused. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has already deposited a sum of Rs.70,000/- before the trial Court.

4. The learned counsel for the respondent would submit that the total arrears comes to Rs.1,60,000/- and after deducting the amount now deposited by the petitioner, the balance amount due is

5.Considering the facts and circumstances and also the reasons assigned for the delay, this Court is inclined to condone the delay. Hence, the petition will be allowed on condition that the petitioner shall deposit another sum of Rs.30,000/- before the Family Court, Dindigul, in M.C.No.21 of 2020, on or before 27.03.2023, failing which, the petition shall stand dismissed automatically.
