This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. Mr.K.A.Thirumalaiappan, learned counsel for the appellants and Mr.S.Thirupathy, learned counsel for the respondents are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.



AWARD

Aggrieved by the award amount of Rs.8,68,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakhs and Sixty Eight Thousand Only) along with interest at 9.5% passed by the Tribunal, the appellant / Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation has filed the present appeal.

2.Now, the parties have arrived at settlement to a sum of Rs.11,30,000/- (Rupees Eleven Lakhs and Thirty Thousand Only) as full quit including a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only), which is deposited for the appeal. The settlement amount shall be paid by the appellant / State Transport Corporation within a period of twelve weeks from today, less the amount already deposited. After such deposit, the claimants are permitted to withdraw the said amount as per the apportionment made by the Tribunal by filing formal application before the Tribunal.

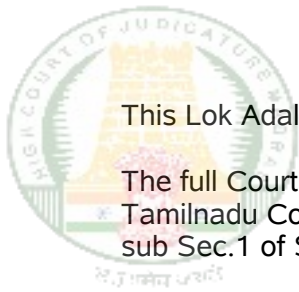
