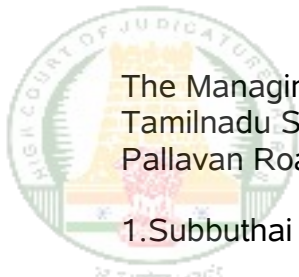

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant Mr.P.Prabhakaran and the counsel for the respondents Mr.N.Thangaraj are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Both parties are present and they accepted for one time settlement for a sum of Rs.30,50,000/- (Rupees Thirty Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) as full quit. The first respondent is entitled for a sum of Rs.12,50,000/- (Rupees Twelve Fifty Thousand only). The second respondent is entitled for a sum of Rs.6,00,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs only). The respondent Nos.3 to 5 are entitled for a sum of Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs only) each. The fifth respondent, who is a minor, shall be deposited in any one of the nationalized Bank, till he attains majority. The appellant / Transport Corporation are directed to deposit the balance amount, if any, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The respondents / claimants are permitted to withdraw the said aforesaid amount without filing any formal permission petition before the Tribunal. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
