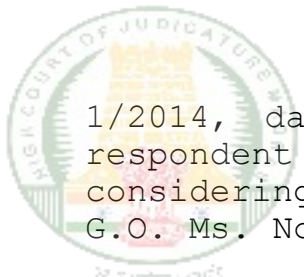
PRAYER IN W.A.(MD)SR.No.7360 of 2023:

1/2014, dated 26.06.2014 and quash the same and direct the respondent to appoint the petitioner as a Secondary Grade teacher by considering the G.O. Ms. No. 16 dated 28.05.2010 and the subsequent G.O. Ms. No. 202 dated 06.08.2012.

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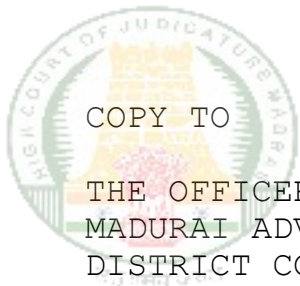
