PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 31 of 2023 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 326(B), 506(2) of IPC, in Crime No.31 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to pathway dispute, the petitioners along with other accused abused the defacto
<https://www.mca.gov.in/ds> in filthy language also attacked him with wooden log and



sticks caused injuries to him. Therefore, the present case to be registered.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioners have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and also submitted that no previous case is pending against these petitioners.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, however, with stringent conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or their appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate Thottiyam, Tiruchy District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned; and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police on every Sunday at 10.30 am until further orders. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of the order copy, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail will stand dismissed.
