Petition filed praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the affidavit filed therewith the High Court may be pleased to issue an order of clarification with regard to the eligibility of arrears of pay and arrears of pension, with reference to Ruling 17 of FR 27 to the writ petitioner who have retired from service much prior to the order of this Honble Court in WP(MD) 10989/2010 dated 11.11.2014 and without assuming charge in the promotional post of Inspector of Police.

Prayer in WP(MD). 10989/ 2010 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a WRIT OF CERTIORARIFIED MANDAMUS, calling for the records relating to the revision of seniority passed by the 3rd Respondent in his proceedings C.No.A2/11308/2008/R.O.No.139/2009 dated 12-06-2009 in so far as Respondent Nos.4 to 16 are concerned and the consequential memorandum passed by the 1st Respondent in his proceedings No.4757/A1/09 dated 29-10-2009 and communicated by the 2nd Respondent in its proceedings C.No.A1/7727/1237/09 dated 27-11-2009 and quash the same as illegal and consequentially to direct the Respondents 1 to 3 to promote the petitioners as Inspectors of Police with effect from the date on which their juniors were promoted.

ORDER : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.Veera kathiravan, Additional Advocate General Assisted by Mr.R.Sureshkumar, Additional Government Pleader for the petitioners and of Mr.V.Thirumal for the respondents 6,7,8,12 & 21, the court made the following order:-

Since there is no contempt, clarification is not necessary.
