year. The Writ Petitioner may therefore take recourse to the appellate procedure as enunciated under the Government Order.

4.No further orders are required.

5.The Writ Petition stands disposed of giving that liberty to the petitioner. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
