Prayer in Crl.MP(MD)No.15669 of 2022 in Crl.OP(MD)No.21378 of 2022:

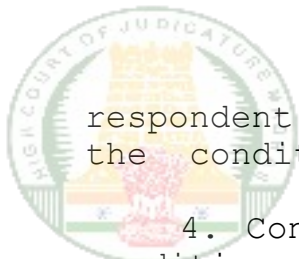
