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ORDER

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This Writ Petition has been filed seeking a Writ of Mandamus, directing the second respondent to permit the petitioner to conduct the Kabadi Tournament schedule to be held on 17.02.2023 to 19.02.2023 at Jallikattu Thidal, Pullambadi, Lalgudi Post, Trichy District, based on the petitioner's representation to the respondents, dated 01.02.2023.

2. Mr.E.Antony Sahaya Prabahar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents would submit that they have been seeking permission to conduct the tournament from 17.02.2023 to 19.02.2023. He would further submit that they may be permitted to conduct the tournament for three days on 17.02.2023, 18.02.2023 and 19.02.2023, from 08.00 am to 05.00 pm.



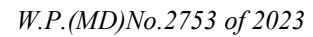
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4. At this juncture, the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner would submit that they are ready to conduct the tournament for three days i.e., on 17.02.2023, 18.02.2023 and 19.02.2023, from 08.00 am to 05.00 pm.

5. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai had issued a circular memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I (1)/2019 dated 09.04.2019 along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the writ petitioner is directed to file an undertaking affidavit incorporating the date and time of the Kabadi tournament before the second respondent and on such filing, the second respondent is
