The Additional Family Court, Coimbatore is directed to transmit the papers to the file of the Family Court, Madurai forthwith. The Family Court, Madurai is directed to dispose I.D.O.P.No.66 of 2023 on merits and in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.

4.In fine, this Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition is allowed. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
