Prayer in CRL A(MD). 51/ 2023 :

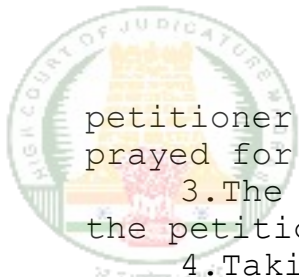
This Petition under Section 14(a) (ii) of SC/St (POA) Act
