07.08.2017 and quash the same and consequently direct the respondents to give the suitable promotion with all monetarily benefits with effect from date of 01.12.2013.

ORDER : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.V.SASIKUMAR, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mr.M.SARANGAN, Additional Government Pleader on behalf of the Respondents, the court made the following order:-
