PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to give permission and adequate police protection for conducting Adal Padal Dance programme on 20.02.2023 in the eve of “Sree Angala Parameshwari and Madurai Veeran” Temple belongs to Keelathaniyam, Ponnamaravathi Taluk, Pudukottai District on the basis of the petitioner's representation, dated 14.02.2023.

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ORDER

The writ petitioner filed this Writ Petition seeking for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to give permission and adequate police protection for conducting Adal Padal Dance programme on 20.02.2023 in the eve of “Sree Angala Parameshwari and Madurai Veeran” Temple belongs to Keelathaniyam, Ponnamaravathi Taluk, Pudukottai District on the basis of the petitioner's representation, dated 14.02.2023.

2. Mr.E.Antony Sahaya Prabahar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner submitted that “Thiru Vizha” of “Sree Angala Parameshwari and Madurai Veeran” Temple belongs to Keelathaniyam, Ponnamaravathi Taluk, Pudukottai District, is going to be held on 20.02.2023. Subsequent to the same, in order to conduct a cultural programme on 20.02.2023, they sought permission of the police by giving a representation dated 14.02.2023.



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But, the second respondent has not considered the said representation.

Since no order was passed, the writ petitioner has come before this Court for the above said relief.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents would submit that there are two groups in the same jurisdiction and the rival group has also decided to conduct the programme on the same day ie., 20.02.2023. He would further submit that the petitioner may be permitted to conduct the programme on 21.02.2023 from 07.00 p.m. to 10.00 p.m.

5. At this juncture, the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner would submit that they are ready to conduct the programme as stated by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

6. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents.



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7. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai had issued a circular memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I (1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the writ petitioner is directed to file an undertaking affidavit incorporating the date and time of the cultural programme before the second respondent police and on such filing, the second respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the writ petitioner, dated 14.02.2023 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

8. With the above direction, this writ petition stands disposed of.
