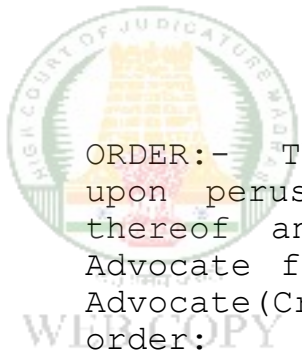

Prayer in Crl.MP(MD).No.3417 of 2023:-

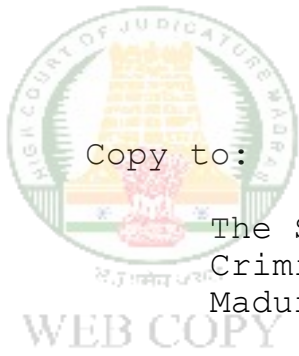
