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ORDER

The petitioners / Accused Nos.2 & 3 have filed this petition to quash the FIR in Crime No.20 of 2020 on the file of the Inspector of Police, All Woman Police Station, Karaikudi District, wherein they were said to have committed offence under Sections 498(A) and 406 IPC.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the marriage was solemnized between the first accused and defacto complainant is 12.12.2018. The first accused has started the matrimonial life with defacto complainant. The defacto complainant's husband after went to the abroad, her husband's family members tortured the defacto complainant stating that her family members cheated them by not giving dowry.
