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ORDER

The petitioner / Accused No.3 has filed this petition to quash the FIR in Crime No.53 of 2021 on the file of the Inspector of Police, Adiramapattinam Police Station, Thanjavur District, wherein he is said to have committed offence under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) IPC.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 14.01.2021, the defacto complainant was standing in the street and talking about the stagnation water in the said street. Due to earlier motive, accused No.1 abused the defacto complainant by using filthy language further accused No.2 stabbed the defacto complainant by using knife and caused injury and threaten with dire consequences. Hence, the defacto complainant preferred a complaint before the respondent police and the same was registered in Crime No.53 of 2021 for the above said offence and to quash the same, the petitioner filed this petition.

3. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate appearing for the first respondent would submit that the investigation in Crime No.53 of 2021 has been completed and



charge sheet has been filed before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Pattukottai and the same was taken on file in C.C.No.92 of 2021.

4. Recording the same, this Criminal Original Petition stands closed with liberty to the petitioner work out his remedy in the manner known to law. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition stands closed.
