Prayer in CRL MP(MD). No.4004 of 2023:-

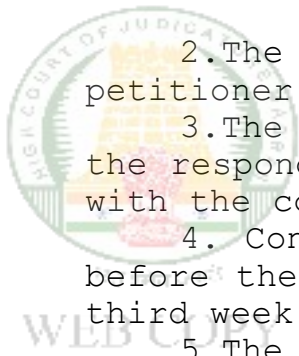
