Prayer in Crl.A.(MD).No.609 of 2022:

To call for records and allow the appeal and acquit the appellants by setting aside the judgment dated 16.06.2022 in S.C.No.98 of 2020 on the file of the Learned Principal District and Sessions Judge, Pudukottai.
