Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to pay 6 percentage interest for the belated payment of Terminal Benefits such as Provident Fund and Leave Salary payable to the petitioner from the date of his retirement (VRS) 31.05.2020 to till the date of actual payment made to him i.e. 01.12.2022 and all other attendant benefits to her within the stipulated period.

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ORDER

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Heard the learned counsel on either side.

2.The writ petitioner joined the respondent corporation as Helper in the year 1986. He retired from service on 31.05.2020. However, his terminal benefits were settled only on 01.12.2022.

3.It is well settled that for such belated settlement, the retired employee is entitled to interest. I, therefore, direct the respondent Corporation to pay the interest to the writ petitioner computed at the rate of 6% per annum on the belated disbursement from the date of retirement till date of settlement. The interest amount shall be paid within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4.This writ petition is allowed accordingly. No costs.
