The petitioner's entitlement to other benefits will abide by the decision to be taken by the first respondent. The petitioner is aged about 90 years. Therefore, it is expected that the first respondent will adhere to the time line stipulated by this Court or do not file any petition for extension of time or drive the petitioner to file contempt



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petition before this Court. It is made clear that I have not gone into the merits of the matter.

3.This writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
