Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondent to pay the petitioner the amount payable towards the encashment of 120 days of earned leaves, surrendered by him in the years 2010 to 2017 before his retirement as admitted by the respondent in the RTI information dated 17.01.2022 either based on his monthly wages of the respective months of surrender of those earned leaves, together with 18% interest p.a. from the respective due dates or based on the monthly wages payable on the month of his retirement together 18% interest from the date of his retirement.
