Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to pay the arrears of petitioner's pension (Rs.1,95,496/-) and gratuity (Rs.5,91,435/-) to a tune of Rs.7,86,931/- from 01.06.2020 to 31.07.2021 and earned leave salary of Rs.4,63,419/- by considering both of petitioner's representations dated 27.01.2023, within the time frame that may be stipulated by this Court.

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ORDER

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Heard the learned counsel on either side.

2. The petitioner was a Sanitary worker in the respondent Corporation. She retired on 31.05.2020. The petitioner seeks disbursement of her terminal benefits. No exception can be taken to the said request.

3. The learned Standing Counsel appearing for the Corporation submits that the matter is being processed and the eligible amount will be paid within a period of eight weeks. The said submission is recorded. The respondent is directed to disburse the petitioner's terminal benefits within the aforesaid period. I make it clear that it will not carry any interest if payment is made within eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Otherwise, it will carry interest at 6% per annum from the date of retirement of the petitioner.

4. This writ petition is allowed on these terms. There shall be no order as to costs.
