Prayer: Writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 1st respondent to consider and pass orders on the petitioner's representation dated 21.12.2022, seeking to issue a formal order, declaring the completion of his probation with effect from 13.06.2015 in the post of Professor(Kayachikitsa) in Government Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital, Kottar, Nagercoil, Kanniyakumari District, as per the provisions of Rule 7 of the Adhoc Rules for the Government Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital, Kottar and Section 32(2) of the Tamil



Nadu Government Servants (Conditions of Service) Act, 2016, within a time frame that may be fixed by this Court.

ORDER

2. The petitioner was appointed as Professor in the Government Ayurveda Medical College and Hospital, Kottar, Nagercoil, Kanyakumari District on 07.06.2013. This appointment made by the second respondent was subsequently ratified by the first respondent on 26.02.2021 vide G.O.(D)No.375 Health and Family Welfare (IMI-1) Department. Now the petitioner seeks declaration of completion of probation with effect from 13.06.2015.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would state that the first respondent has to pass order and the representation has also been given.



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4. The learned Special Government Pleader states that the second respondent is competent to consider the petitioner's request. Be that as it may, the competent authority / the respondents herein are directed to pass order on the petition mentioned representation on merits and in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
