4. If it is so, the 2nd respondent can dispose the representation that was made by the petitioner within a week from the date of receipt of copy of this order. If the petitioner is aggrieved outcome of the order of



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the 2nd respondent, he can workout his remedy through appropriate proceedings.

5. With the above direction, this writ petition stands disposed of.
