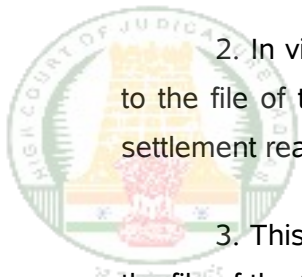

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s K.KUBENDRAN and the counsel for the respondent/s C.RAJESH KANNAN are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

### **AWARD**

This transfer civil miscellaneous petition is at the instance of the wife to transfer HMOP No.91 of 2022 from the file of the Sub Court, Thiruchentoor to the file of the Family Court, Madurai. HMOP No.91 of 2022 has been filed by the husband seeking restitution of conjugal rights. Today, the petitioner as well as the respondent are present and their respective counsels. The petitioner wife is willing to join the respondent husband. After several negotiations, they have agreed that they will file necessary 13 B application seeking for mutual consent divorce before the appropriate competent Court. However, it has been agreed between the petitioner and the respondent that the respondent husband shall pay a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- and shall also not insist on return of any jewelry from the respondent wife. These terms shall be recorded in the consent divorce petition before the competent civil Court.



2. In view of the above terms, the parties also agree that HMOP NO.91 of 2022 carried to the file of the Family Court, Madurai to enable the parties to work out further process the settlement reached today.

3. This Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition is allowed and HMOP No.91 of 2022 is withdrawn from the file of the Sub Court, Thiruchenthoor, and transferred to the file of the Family Court, Madurai.
