For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.25 of 2023 on the file of the Respondent Police.

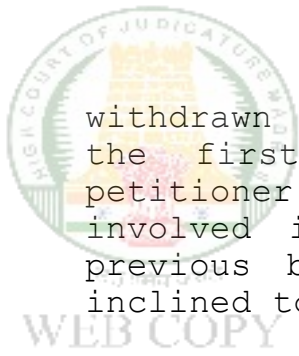
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

3. It is seen that this is the second application for anticipatory bail and the earlier application was dismissed as

withdrawn on 24.02.2023 in Crl.O.P(MD) No. 3649 of 2023. For the first petitioner involved in 16 previous cases, second petitioner involved in 9 previous cases and the third petitioner involved in five previous cases. Taking into consideration the previous bad antecedents of the petitioners, this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

4. Hence the petition stands dismissed.
