ORDER

Therefore, the petitioner and other parties may appear before the third respondent herein and the third respondent may enquire both the parties in groups and depending upon the outcome of the above said enquiry, further orders may be passed, on its own merits, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. This writ petition is disposed of accordingly. No costs.
