These writ petitions are filed for issuance of a writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to assign the land in S.No.15/1 situated at Ponmeni Village for housing plots to the members of Dr.



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Ambedkar Residential Colony by taking into account the 4th respondent's proceedings in letter, dated 27.10.2016 and the 6th respondent's proceedings, dated 18.01.2019 and the petitioners' representation dated 12.10.2020.

2. On instructions, the learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents 2 to 4 submitted that the petitioners in both the writ petitions were granted alternative site. But the petitioners are refusing to move to the said site.

3.This Court is of the considered opinion that the petitioners cannot choose the property. The respondents have taken the petitioners' plight into consideration and have granted alternative site. Therefore, these writ petitions cannot be maintained.
