PRAYER :-

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A3, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 379 IPC in Crime No.159 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.
