Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to disburse the Medical Reimbursement Claim of Rs.8,92,346/- (Rupees Eight Lakhs Ninety Two Thousand and Three Hundred Forty Six only) incurred for the treatment of Health care to the petitioner's wife under the Government of Tamil Nadu New Health Insurance Scheme-2022 by considering the representation made by the petitioner dated 27.02.2023 within a time stipulated by this Court.

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel on either side.

2. The writ petitioner is a senior citizen. He is a retired government employee. He is a member of the Tamil Nadu New Health Insurance Scheme. On 29.09.2022, the petitioner's wife met with an



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accident. The petitioner incurred a sum of Rs.8,92,346/-. The petitioner made a claim for disbursement. It has not been since considered.

3. As per the norms set out in the insurance scheme, accidents are also covered. The petitioner's wife was hit by two-wheeler. It is a case of motor accident. In my view, it would also be covered by the terms of the scheme. The petitioner is therefore directed to resubmit a claim before the fifth respondent along with the original bills. The fifth respondent shall process and forward it to the third respondent within a period of three weeks after receipt of the scheme. The fifth respondent is directed to sanction the claim and pay the eligible amount to the petitioner as per the norms within a period of eight weeks thereafter.

4. The Writ Petition is allowed on these terms. No costs.
