This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Ms.K.R.Shivashankari and the counsel for the respondent/s Mr.G.Prabhu Rajadurai are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with



the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.



### **AWARD**

Already the Tribunal has passed an award of Rs.16,98,500/- with 7.5% interest. After due deliberation, both the parties have agreed for settlement of Rs.15,75,000/- as full quit. The excess amount if any, shall be refunded to the Insurance Company. The first respondent is permitted to withdraw a sum of Rs.8,00,000/-, the second respondent is permitted to withdraw a sum of Rs. 2,75,000/-, the third respondent is permitted to withdraw a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- and the fourth respondent is permitted to withdraw a sum of Rs.2,50,000/-.
