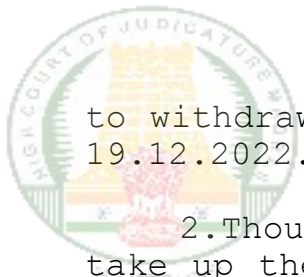
Prayer in CRL A(MD). 501/ 2022 :

Order : This petition coming up for orders on this day, upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.DEENADHAYALAN S, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mr.E.ANTONY SAHAYA PRABAHAR, Additional Public Prosecutor, on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-

The earlier petition seeking suspension of sentence filed by the very same petitioner, having been considered, was dismissed as withdrawn on 19.12.2022, wherein the plea raised by the petitioner, seeking parity with the co-accused, having been considered, was ~~about to be~~ rejected. Therefore, sensing the same, the petitioner wanted



to withdraw the petition and the same was dismissed as with on 19.12.2022.

2. Though the date has been fixed sometime in February, 2023 to take up the main appeal, due to want of time it could not be taken up. Therefore, we feel that this petition can also be dismissed by fixing the date sometime in June 2023 for final hearing of the main appeal. Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is dismissed.
