PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.19/2022 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A1, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 417, 419, 120(B) and 109 of I.P.C., in Crime No.19 of 2022 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution the defacto complainant purchased the property comprised in Survey Nos.244/7, 242B/3 and 279/6 through a registered sale deed, dated 03.06.2019, at Pookudaiyur Village from three persons, namely Kamalam, Emi Malika and Backiaselvi. The defacto complainant came to know that the petitioners are the agents, who created the above-said forged sale deed by impersonating the original owner of the property, who are A5 and A6. The defacto complainant filed a direction under Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C before the Special Judicial Magistrate (FAC) Special Court for



Anti-Land Grabbing Cases, Tirunelveli in Cr.M.P.No.8442 of the same was ordered on 06.07.2022. Hence, the said case was registered.

3.Heard. Perused the materials available on record, including the First Information Report.

4.This is the second application for anticipatory bail and the earlier application for anticipatory bail was dismissed by this Court on 07.03.2023 in Crl.O.P(MD) No.2086 of 2023 and there is no change in circumstances of the case to consider the present anticipatory bail petition even after dismissal of the petition, hence this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Hence the petition stands dismissed.
