PRAYER :-

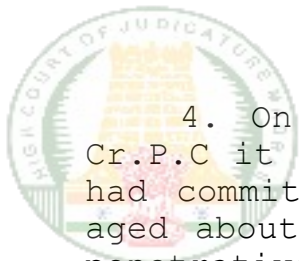
For Bail in Crime No.4/2023 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/sole accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 28.02.2023 for the offence punishable under Sections 5(j)(ii)r/w.6 of POCSO Act,2019 in crime No.4 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner herein under the pretext of love had committed penetrative sexual assault on the minor victim girl and also threatened her not to disclose the same to anyone, hence the case.

3. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report and also the statement of the victim recorded under section 164 of Cr.P.C.



4. On perusal of the statement recorded under sect 54 Cr.P.C it is revealed that the petitioner under the pretext of love had committed penetrative sexual assault on the minor victim girl aged about 16 years. That apart he has also compelled her to have penetrative sexual assault and also threatened her not to disclose the same to any one. Further only during the medical check up it was found that the victim was pregnant. Further the petitioner has committed a very serious and heinous offence as against the minor victim girl, hence this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Hence the petition stands dismissed.
