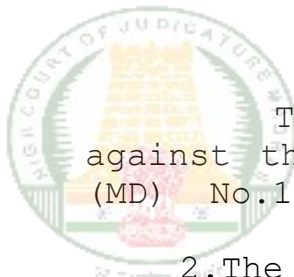
PRAYER IN CRL MP(MD)No. 1174 of 2020:

PRAYER IN CRL RC(MD)No. 133 of 2020:

Pleased to grant exemption to surrender before the trial court in pursuance of the dismissal of C.A.NO. 154/2018 by the learned Sessions Judge, Thiruchirappalli by Judgment dated 20.04.2019, pending disposal of the above Criminal Revision Petition.
