Prayer:Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records pertaining to the selection list of eligible candidates dated 28.04.2021 for oral test in the form of interview which is published in the website of 1st respondent, insofar as non-inclusion of petitioner's name for oral test scheduled to hold from 08.06.2021 to 11.06.2021 and quash the same as illegal and unconstitutional, consequently direct the respondents to permit the petitioner for oral test in the form of interview as schedule from 08.06.2021 to 11.06.2021 for the post of Motor Vehicle Inspectors Grade-II, in the Tamilnadu Transport Subordinate Service, 2013-2018 within the time stipulated by this Court.

Since the issue raised in these writ petitions is one and the same, these writ petitions are disposed of by way of this common order.



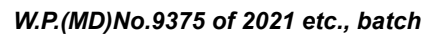
