PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.141/2023 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

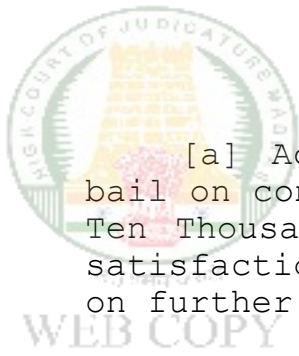
The petitioner /A1 who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 20.02.2023 for the offences under sections 406,420,468,294(b), 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.141 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that A1 promised the defacto complainant that he would arrange job for his son at Electricity Board and received a sum of s.7,21,000/- and thereafter cheated him by neither securing job nor repaying the amount, hence the case.

3. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

4. It is seen that the petitioner had received a sum of Rs.7,21,000/- from the defacto complainant for getting job in the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board. The petitioner was working as a Commercial Inspector in Tamil Nadu Electricity Board and now he is ready and willing to pay some reasonable amount to the defacto complainant. Taking into consideration the facts and submissions made by the learned counsels and also the period of incarceration this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner , subject to

[a] Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on condition to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai and on further conditions that:

[b] the petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs only) to the defacto complainant directly and produce the acknowledgement for payment at the time of furnishing sureties. On verification of the same, the concerned Magistrate is directed to accept the sureties furnished by the petitioner.

[c] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

[d] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 A.M. and 5.30P.M., for a period of four weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

[e] the petitioner shall not commit any offences of similar nature.

[f] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[g] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[h] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[i] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
