PRAYER :-

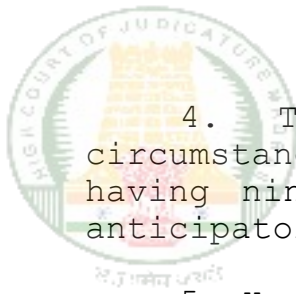
For Anticipatory Bail in Cr No.87/2023 on the file of the

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A2, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the
respondent Police for the offences punishable under Sections 341,294
(b), 324 and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.87 of 2023 on the file of
the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to some dispute in
taking fishing rights contract, the petitioner herein along with
other accused waylaid the defacto complainant abused him, attacked
him and also threatened with dire consequences. Hence, the
complaint.
