PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Cr No.87/2023 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 120 (b),147,302 of IPC in Crime No.87 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to previous enmity on 05.02.2023 A1 and A2 had assaulted the deceased and caused his death, thence the case.

3. Heard both side and perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

4. It is seen that in the First Information Report there are <https://www.judiciary.gov.in/> named accused. After investigation other accused have been



implicated as an accused under section 120(b) of IPC. The petitioner herein is arrayed as A9. Even according to the case of prosecution the petitioner along with other accused conspired together and helped the other accused to commit the murder. The petitioner has no specific overt act. That apart other accused have been arrested and released on bail. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, with certain conditions:

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two blood sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am., and 5.30 pm., until further orders.

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

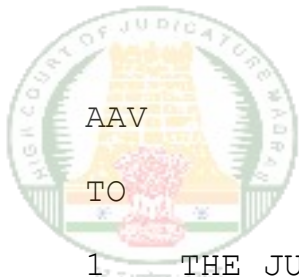
[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
