This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant Mr.R.Rajamohan and the counsel for the respondents Mr.V.Esakkimuthu are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Both parties are present and they accepted for one time settlement for a sum of Rs.33,50,000/- (Rupees Thirty Three Lakhs Fifty Thousand only). The first respondent, by name, Ramalatchmi, the fourth respondent, by name, Shanthi, and the fifth respondent, by name, Mahalakshmi are entitled for a sum of Rs.8,00,000/- (Rupees Eight Lakhs only) each. The second respondent, by name, Vasanthi and the third respondent, by name, Chithra, are entitled for a sum of Rs.4,75,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand only) each. The appellant / Transport Corporation has already deposited the entire award amount by the Tribunal. The rest of the amount will be refunded to the appellant, if any. The respondents / claimants are permitted to withdraw the said aforesaid amount without filing any formal permission petition before the Tribunal. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
