PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 69/2023 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A3 who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 294(b), 365, 386, 342, 307, 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No. 69 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The defacto complainant who is the wife of the victim lodged complaint stating that the husband of the defacto complainant is working as Professor and the mother of the first accused is working as Typist in Tamil University and whileso the husband of the defacto complainant had sent message to the mother of the first accused. Aggrieved over the same, on 14.03.2023 while the husband of the defacto complainant was returning home, the first accused had contacted him and asked him to come to Arasur temple and while he was going there all the accused persons attacked him with aruval and crow bar and also criminally intimidated him, hence the case.

3. Heard both side and perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

4. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital, this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner , with certain conditions:

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Thanjavur on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am., for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.

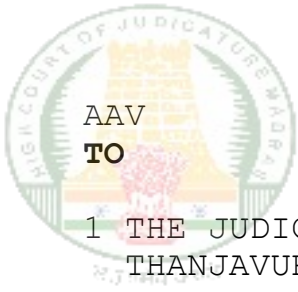
