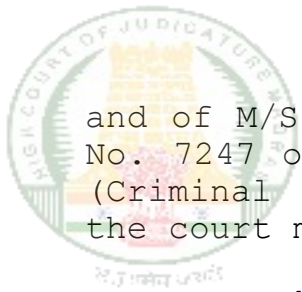
Prayer in CRL MP(MD)No. 7050/ 2023 in CRL OP(MD)No. 13977 of 2022:
