This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr. P.Ganapathi Subramanian and the counsel for the respondent/s Mr.R.Paranjothi are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.



AWARD

Both the parties and their counsels are present. After due deliberation, they are agreed to settle the case for a sum of Rs.15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs only) towards full and final settlement. The appellant/defendant is agreed to pay the above said amount through Demand Draft as full and final settlement of the decree passed in O.S.No. 12 of 2016 within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, failing which, the decree passed by the trial Court in O.S.No. 12 of 2016 shall stand confirmed. The respondent/plaintiff is also agreed to receive the above amount of Rs.15,00,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakhs only) as full and final settlement of the above decree.

The Court fee paid shall be refunded to the parties in the manner provided under the Court Fees Act 1870, as provided for under Sub Section 1 of Section 21 of the LSA Act 1987 as amended in 1994.

The original of the award shall be placed in the Court record and copy of the award shall be kept with High Court Legal Service Committee and one copy each is furnished to both parties free of cost.

In agreement of the above, both parties and their counsel have affixed their signature/ thumb impressions in presence of the Lok Adalat Bench admitting the terms and conditions and accordingly.
