### **ORDER**

A direction is issued to the first respondent to proceed with the enquiry and ensure that an opportunity is given to both the petitioner and the fourth respondent and thereafter endeavour to dispose of the enquiry within a period of 12 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
