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22.07.2017 with retrospective effect and consequently on the base of the same to revise all terminal benefits and pension and to disburse the difference amount and pension to the petitioner along with the interest at the rate of 6 percentage interest on the base of the petitioner's representation, dated 22.02.2020.

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed to direct the respondents to promote the petitioner to post of Ticket Checking Inspector from 22.07.2017 with retrospective effect and consequently on the base of the same to revise all terminal benefits and pension and to disburse the difference amount and pension to the petitioner along with the interest at the rate of 6 percentage interest on the base of the petitioner's representation, dated 22.02.2020.



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2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner joined as a Conductor on 01.08.1986. After completion of 32 years service in respondent Corporation, the petitioner retired as a Ticket Checking Inspector on 31.10.2018 on attaining the age of superannuation. The petitioner made an application on 22.02.2020 to the respondents and requested them to promote the petitioner as Checking Inspector from 22.02.2017 with retrospective effect and the same was not considered. Hence the present writ petition is filed with the aforesaid prayer.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that this Court may issue a direction to the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 22.02.2020 within a reasonable time as fixed by this Court.

4. Considering the limited request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation, dated 22.02.2020 and pass appropriate orders on merits and



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in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
