2.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that since the temple festival to be commenced in the last week of May 2023, the petitioner seeks the above modification.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that the petitioner has been complying with the condition regularly.

4.Considering the nature of offence, the condition imposed by this court in Crl.M.P(MD)No.3674 of 2018 in Crl.A.(MD)No.246 of 2018 dated 18.05.2018 is modified only in the month of June 2023 alone and the petitioner shall report before the trial Court on 11.06.2023 and for the other months, the earlier order of this Court remains unaltered.
